

ORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO PARKING OF PASSENGER CARS AND ½ TON TRUCKS ON CERTAIN STREET AND AS TO PARKING OF BUTANE, GASOLINE OR PROPANE TRUCKS AND REGULATING TRAFFIC AT A CERTAIN INTERSECTION IN SAID TOWN; PROVIDING FOR A FINE AND COSTS FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

- (A) Only passenger cars and ½ ton trucks may be parked on Division Street in the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, from First Street to Third Street, except for the purpose of loading and unloading.
- (B) Gasoline, butane and propane trucks are not to be parked at any time in the district comprising that bounded by Oak Street on the South, Third Street on the west, Olive Street on the north and Front Street on the east in Stilwell, Oklahoma.
- (C) All traffic at the intersection of Division Street and Second Street in Stilwell, Oklahoma, shall come to a complete stop at the stop signs provided, before proceeding to cross the street.
- (D) All violations of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of \$1.00 or fine and costs not to exceed \$10.00.
- (E) For the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and approval.
