

ORDINANCE NO. 11

AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING SECTION 85 OF THE CITY CHARTER OF STILWELL;  
PROVIDING A MEANS FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF SAID SECTION, IN ADDITION TO THE  
PENALTIES THEREIN PROVIDED; AND DECLARING EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION I. That any person or persons violating Section 85 of the City Charter of Stilwell, Oklahoma, by the keeping of swine within the surveyed limits of said City and who shall have been convicted thereof and fined and who does not pay said fine and costs shall be dealt with as follows:

SECTION II. The Police Court may issue its order directed to the City Marshal to seize the animal or animals, the keeping of which within said City caused said fine and costs to be assessed, directing that said Marshal shall seize said swine and shall impound same for not less than 5 days and shall advertise the sale of said swine by posting notices in three public places in said City providing for the sale at public auction of said swine or as many thereof as may be required to pay the fine heretofore referred to, together with the costs, as well as the costs of seizure of said animal or animals, the upkeep of same and the cost of sale.

SECTION III. The said City Marshal shall charge as costs the following: \$1.00 for the seizure of such animal or animals and \$1.00 each for necessary deputies required to seize said animals or animals, not to exceed \$5.00 for hauling said animals to a place where they are to be kept, \$1.00 for advertising the same, \$1.00 for sale, and pay for necessary feed while held.

SECTION IV. Said Marshal, within 10 days from seizure shall make his return to the Police Court showing the manner of execution of its order and shall pay the proceeds of sale to Police Court to be disposed of as provided herein. Any residue is to be paid the owner of said swine.

SECTION V. The health, peace and safety of the citizens of said Stilwell being involved herein an emergency is declared, and said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its publication.
