

ORDINANCE NO. 47

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING CHARGES FOR WATER AND SEWER SERVICE; PROVIDING RULES AND REGULATIONS APPROVED BY THE STILWELL AREA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That Resolution of the Trustees of the Stilwell Area Development Authority enacted on the 18th day of May, 1964, which relates to charges for water when delivered through meters and for sewer services, and setting out rules and regulations for efficient operation and control of the water and sewer system, which Resolution by reference is made a part of this Ordinance as if herein set out in full, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. For the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
