

ORDINANCE NO. 144

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 126 OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL,
OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That WHEREAS, heretofore an Ordinance to govern a franchise for a community television antenna system, to declare an emergency and for other purposes was passed by the Mayor and Council of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, and designated Ordinance No. 126; and WHEREAS, for good cause shown, the Council of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, has voted to repeal in its entirety said Ordinance No. 126.

SECTION 2. That Ordinance No. 126 of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, be and the same is hereby repealed, revoked, set aside and cancelled and that all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
