

ORDINANCE NO. 262

AN ORDINANCE FIXING ADDITIONAL BENEFITS FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA, BY RATIFYING ACTION OF CITY COUNCIL IN 1982, IMPLEMENTING AND AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL BENEFITS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma:

SECTION 1. That in 1982 the City Council, pursuant to authority granted by the City Charter, adopted an ordinance whose provisions authorized additional benefits for elected officials by payment of premiums of their group hospitalization insurance plan adopted by the City. Additional family members were made eligible at the sole expense of the elected official.

SECTION 2. That such additional benefits have been incorporated in the budget and approved for each year thereafter to the present.

SECTION 3. That the memorialization of the action of the Council in 1982 has been lost or misplaced and said action is hereby ratified and such benefits are approved for continued distribution to elected officials in conformity with the budget heretofore approved for 1993-1994 and hereinafter until the same is rescinded by duly adopted ordinance.

SECTION 4. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
