

ORDINANCE NO. 359

AN ORDINANCE SETTING GARBAGE AND REFUSE COLLECTION RATES FOR RESIDENTIAL, COMMERCIAL, AND OTHER RATES AS HEREIN PROVIDED FOR THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA, REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma;

SECTION 1. Effective December 1, 2011, the rate for collection and removal of garbage and refuse within the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma should be as follows:

Residential (In City)	1 day per week pick-up	\$8.00 per month
Residential (Out of City)	1 day per week pick-up	\$10.00 per month
Commercial	1 day per week pick-up	\$35.00 per month
Commercial	3 day per week pick-up	\$75.00 per month
Commercial	5 day per week pick-up	\$125.00 per month

SECTION 2. Effective December 1, 2012, the rate for collection and removal of garbage and refuse within the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma should be as follows:

Residential (In City)	1 day per week pick-up	\$9.00 per month
Residential (Out of City)	1 day per week pick-up	\$11.00 per month
Commercial	1 day per week pick-up	\$40.00 per month
Commercial	3 day per week pick-up	\$80.00 per month
Commercial	5 day per week pick-up	\$130.00 per month

SECTION 3. Effective December 1, 2013, the rate for collection and removal of garbage and refuse within the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma should be as follows:

Residential (In City)	1 day per week pick-up	\$10.00 per month
Residential (Out of City)	1 day per week pick-up	\$12.00 per month
Commercial	1 day per week pick-up	\$45.00 per month
Commercial	3 day per week pick-up	\$85.00 per month
Commercial	5 day per week pick-up	\$135.00 per month

SECTION 4. All residents who are age 65 or older at the passage of this ordinance may elect to receive a discounted rate for residential pick-up of \$6.50 per month by making application at the Stilwell Utility Department 925 W. Hickory Street, Stilwell, Oklahoma no later than November 21, 2011.

SECTION 5. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
