

STILWELL CITY ORDINANCE NO. 362

DISORDERLY CONDUCT/ PUBLIC NUISANCE

1. DISORDERLY CONDUCT DEFINED.

WHENEVER PEOPLE ENGAGE IN CONDUCT THAT IS LIKELY TO CAUSE A DISTURBANCE OR LEAD TO SOME SORT OF NON-PEACEFUL EVENT. ANY BEHAVIOR THAT IS LIKELY TO CAUSE ALARM, ANGER, ANNOYANCE OR AN INCREASED LIKELIHOOD TO ENGAGE IN UNLAWFUL ACTIVITY.

- FIGHTING- FIGHTING, BRAWLING, OR PHYSICAL SCUFFLES.
- PROTESTS- WHILE ENGAGING IN PEACEFUL PROTESTS IS A CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHT, A DISRUPTIVE PROTEST ARE NOT.
- DISTURBING AN ASSEMBLY- INTERRUPTING A CITY COUNCIL MEETING, BOARD MEETING, PUBLIC RALLY, OR A RELIGIOUS CEREMONY.
- PUBLIC MISCONDUCT- ENGAGING IN WHAT IS NORMALLY PRIVATE CONDUCT IN A PUBLIC PLACE, (I.E PUBLIC URINATION, SEXUAL ACTS, ETC.)
- PUBLICLY DISTURBING THE PEACE (ANY PUBLIC AREA, RECREATIONAL AREA, OR PUBLIC STREET , ALLEY OR ROADWAY)
- ANY DISPLAY OF OFFENSIVE, OBSCENE RUDE OR ANIMATED BEHAVIOR IN A PUBLIC PLACE.
