

ORDINANCE NO. 44

AN ORDINANCE ANNULING, VACATING AND DISCONTINUING THE PUBLIC USE OF SEVENTH STREET BEGINNING AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH SOUTH LINE OF THE ALLEY IN BLOCK 4 AND 5 OF ALLEN ADDITION SOUTH TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH OAK STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF STILWELL:

SECTION 1. It has been by proper consideration determined that the public use of that portion of Seventy Street beginning at its intersection with the south line of the alley in blocks 4 and 5 of the Allen Addition, southerly to its intersection with Oak Street, is no longer deemed necessary, and the same is hereby annulled, vacated and discontinued, and the same shall revert to the owners of real estate thereto adjacent in the manner prescribed by law.
