

ORDINANCE NO. 92

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA, AND CHANGING THE CITY'S BOUNDARY TO INCLUDE SUCH TERRITORY, AND DESIGNATING SUCH TERRITORY AS THE QUALLS ADDITION TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That the following described real property situate adjacent to and abutting upon the present corporate limits of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, shall be annexed to and become part of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, to wit:

A subdivision of that portion of the W/2, SE/4, NE/4 of Section 34, Township 16 North, Range 25 East, described as follows: Beginning at a point 25 feet East and 463 feet North of the Southwest corner of the W/2, SE/4, NE/4 of Section 34, thence North 441 feet, thence East 293 feet, thence South 349 feet, thence in a Southwesterly direction to the point of beginning; and

A tract of land 25 feet wide lying Easterly of a line beginning at the Northwest corner of the South 363 feet of the SW/4, SE/4, NE/4 of said section, and running North 0 degrees, 01' 15" West, 100 feet,

a plat of which said property is attached hereto and made a part hereof as though described herein.

SECTION 2. That the real property herein described shall be designated as the **QUALLS ADDITION** to the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, and the boundaries of said City are herewith changed to correspond to the legal description first above given.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
