

ORDINANCE NO. 166

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ANY PRIOR ORDINANCES OR RESOLUTIONS DECLARING THAT A FLOOD PLAIN EXISTS IN THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA; AND PROVIDING THAT THERE BE NO FLOOD PLAIN EXISTENT IN THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

THAT all ordinances and resolutions heretofore passed by the City Council of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, decreeing that there be established a flood plain within the corporate limits of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, be and they are hereby repealed and set aside.

THAT from and after the date of passage of this Ordinance, there shall be no flood plain in existence in the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, for the reason that no danger of flood exists within the said limits of the said City.
