
AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 284 AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR REPEAL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, STATE OF OKLAHOMA:


THAT effective from and after May 6, 2007, City of Stilwell Ordinance No. 284 is hereby repealed.

**CITY OF STILWELL
ORDINANCE NO. 342
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
ORDINANCE NO. 284, PROVIDING
FOR ADDITIONAL DUTIES AND
INCREASING SALARY.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, STATE OF OKLAHOMA.

SECTION 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 57, heretofore passed by the Council of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, on the 4th day of August 1997 be and the same is hereby amended as follows, to wit:

SECTION 2. The City Clerk Treasurer is hereby appointed to discharge the position of Purchasing Agent for the City of Stilwell and to such perform additional duties as determined by the City Council. The City Clerk Treasurer shall be compensated the sum of \$2,521.01 per month for such additional duties, said duties and compensation shall cease at the end of the elected term of office the City Clerk Treasurer on May 6, 2007.

SECTION 2. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
