

## ORDINANCE 385-2020-C

### AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE PENALTY FOR NON-COMPLIANCE WITH ORDINANCES 385-2020, 385-2020-A, & 385-2020-B.

**WHEREAS**, an annual update of fees and permits for activities within the City of Stilwell, as required by Ordinance 385, is of paramount importance for intelligent oversight and fiscal responsibility, and

**WHEREAS**, the responsibility for such is the lawful responsibility of the City of Stilwell,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:**

**ARTICLE 1 – ORDINANCE 385-2020** shall forthwith be amended as per the following:

#### **ARTICLE 5 – PENALTY FOR NON-COMPLIANCE**

Current content to be replaced with the following:

*“Any person, firm, or corporation in violation of the requirements of this ordinance may be subject to a penalty in the amount equal to, but not more than, twice the amount of the original fee(s) assessed for every month they are in violation. Any work being done may be stopped until compliance with proper permits and licenses are obtained. If work already completed interferes with a full and complete inspection, it may be required to be removed to ensure compliance with current ordinances. After three months of non-compliance, a commercial facility can be summarily closed until the facility is in compliance.”*

#### **ARTICLE 2 – Reliability**

All other sections of Ordinance 385-2020, 385-2020-A, and 385-2020-B are to remain in full force and effect.
