

ORDINANCE 400-A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 400 CONCERNING TRASH PLACEMENT AND DUMPSTER USAGE WITHIN THE CITY OF STILWELL

WHEREAS, Trash Service by the City of Stilwell is a purchased service; and

WHEREAS, the health and safety of both the citizens of Stilwell and municipal employees is of paramount importance; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of this Council that adequate guidelines are essential for the efficient and effective fulfillment of the purpose of the Stilwell Sanitation Department,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

ORDINANCE 400 shall forthwith be amended as per the following:

ARTICLE 1: Section 1 – Rules, Prohibitions, Special Pick Up (1) (d) shall add the following:

- d. On non-trash days, trash containers should be placed as close to the residence or business as possible, at a minimum they need to be moved outside of the City easement areas.

ARTICLE 2: The following shall be added as SECTION 2 - DUMPSTERS:

1. Dumpsters are available for placement from the Street Department. The monthly cost of the dumpster will be determined through the current version of Ordinance 385. There is also a two (2) week dumpster rental available with fees established through Ordinance 385. Contact the Street Department for availability and placement.
2. Some items will not be permitted in the dumpster due to environmental concerns and/or weight. Items not allowed to be placed in the dumpster are:
 - a. Batteries
 - b. Tires
 - c. Concrete
 - d. Paint
 - e. Shingles
 - f. Brick, block or ceramic tile
 - g. Brush or tree trimmings
 - h. Lumber over four (4) feet long
 - i. No more than half of the dumpster can consist of sheet rock
3. Do not over fill the dumpster. In the event the dumpster becomes full before the scheduled pickup, the dumpster can be emptied earlier for an administrative fee, which is established in Ordinance 385.
4. All items desired to be removed must be contained within the dumpster. Any items or trash outside of the dumpster will not be picked up, without making prior arrangements with the Street Department.
5. Dumpsters are for the refuse of the specific location the containers and dumpsters are located.

ARTICLE 3: The following SECTION numbers are changed.

| 7. SECTION 8: | Repeal and Severability | is now SECTION 9 |

ARTICLE 4: All costs for trash pickup and dumpster use will be in accordance with the current version of ordinance 385.

ARTICLE 5: All sections of Ordinance 400 remain in full force and effect.
